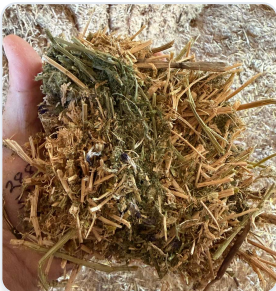

Large line of utility grade vetch hay, only graded down from prime due to colour loss and windrows being blown around while curing otherwise presents really nicely should still test very well. Excellent solid bales will freight very well.
