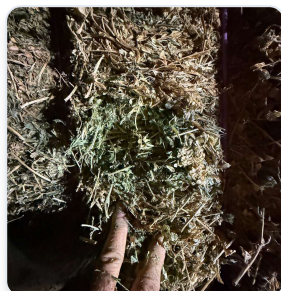

You can smell a little bit of dust. It was low yielding only about a tonne and a half to the hectare. Exceptional Vetch Hay.
